The Golden Age of Science Fiction Nov 18 2021 John Wade grew up in the 1950s, a decade that has since been dubbed the 'golden age of science fiction'. This book is a personal account of John Wade's fascination with the genre across all the entertainment media in which it appeared – the sort of stuff he revelled in as a young boy – and still enjoys today.
