On August 24th 79 AD Mt Vesuvius erupted the destruction of Pompeii killed about 2 000 Pompeii citizens which is 13 percent of Pompeii's total population. It was one of the deadliest eruptions ever. The lava was about 1 300 degrees. The eruption happened so fast that nobody had time to fully evacuate.
