Ancient egyptian language egyptian is the oldest known indigenous language of egypt and a branch of the afroasiatic language family written records of the egyptian language have been dated from about 3400 bc making it one of the oldest recorded languages known outside of sumerian.

**On the basis of ancient texts scholars generally divide the history of egyptian language into five periods old egyptian from before 3000 to about 2200 bce middle egyptian c 2200 c**

**1600 bce late egyptian c 1550 c 700 bce demotic c 700 bce c 400 ce and coptic c 2nd century ce until at least the 17th century**

Modern standard arabic is the official language of the african country of egypt and is used in most written documents and taught in schools across the country arabic was introduced to egypt under the arab occupation arabic easily became integrated with other semitic languages such as syriac berber and assyrian to form other variants of arabic spoken in the country today.

Cuneiform tablet akkadian was one of the first written languages along with sumerian elamite and ancient egyptian however unlike these other languages akkadian spread in use throughout the near east egypt and even reached cyprus by the 2nd millennium bc.
