To write dialogue in a classic screenplay format you will need your character s name centered in block capitals beneath it slightly to the left you will want to write the actual dialogue when you want to add dialogue that is offscreen write o s next to the character s name write os for when they return on screen

If you ever find yourself writing a character s dialogue in the action lines chances are it should go in description like this dialogue format quirk 3 misusing v o and o s sometimes cues are added next to a character s name in order to indicate we can hear them speaking but they re not actually in the scene. Unless you re writing a film script or a stage play it s best to maintain a balance between dialogue and exposition try breaking up long passages of exposition with short dialogue even a sentence or two can be refreshing.
